It is time to follow SASS rules 100%

CHANGES OVER YEARS PAST IN A NUTSHELL:

-  ALL PISTOLS 1911 -45 CAL
-  RIFLES – BIG BORE
-  AMMO – 180 GR MIN
-  MAGS – NO EXTENDED BASES (PLASTIC) must be flush steel
-  NO re-holstering of pistol, it will be staged after the firing sequence
-  NO shotgun make-ups
-  3 Stages

THE ABBREVIATED RULES

THE GUNS:

- PISTOLS Any 5" bushing barrel 1911 45 that meets the Modern & Traditional class criteria as defined below in the CLASSES section.
- RIFLE Any SASS approved big bore lever rifle - .40 cal minimum.
- SHOTGUN Model 1897's and replicas only.

OTHER INFO:

- AMMO** Must be ALL LEAD! No exceptions! Minimum weight 180 grain, POWER FACTOR of 150.
- LEATHER / CANVAS** Period correct holsters must safely secure the pistols. If not, please stage them. No cross draws or shoulder holsters allowed. Magazine pouches will be worn on opposite side of holster in a vertical fashion.

CLASSES – available for Ladies and Men

- TRADITIONAL** Box stock service model, fixed sights, stock grip safety no extended safety, mag release, or slide release. No checkering, or extra serrations. Grips are G.I. wood or plastic. As Plain Jane as you can get. May be internally accurized, but no recoil systems. Beveling of mag well is allowed.

Example – Springfield GI model/Mil Spec, Rock Island Mil Spec, or Para Ordnance SASS model.

Must shoot one handed, unsupported. Unsupported hand may assist in clearing jams and racking slide. If you have a “Traditional” gun and want to shoot two-handed, then sign up for Modern.

- MODERN** Enhanced versions of 1911’s or others allowed- beaver tails, extended safety, slide release, mag release, as well as ambi safety. Checkering, serrations, stippling. Adjustable sights, custom fixed sights. Full length guide rod. Grips can be wood or plastic. Match trigger, commander hammer, and beveled mag well are OK.

You may shoot with both hands.

Stainless steel is OK. No recoil reducers, e.g., compensators, porting, mercury tubes, etc. No extended barrels, bull barrels or weighted barrels. All guns must have a bushing system. No optical sights. No fiber optics. Only metal sights. No mag wells. No rubber grips. No composite grips. No target grips or thumb rests. All mags- 8 round max capacity, but we will only load 5. NO

BASE PADS, Stainless steel mags are OK. No oversize mag releases.

STAGES

Three stages up to 20 rounds of pistol per stage, 10 rifle, 4-6 shotgun. So, you will need at least 4 mags.

RULES

Load rifle as usual at any CAS match. Shotgun will be loaded with 4+ rounds in the magazine, bolt will be closed on an empty chamber. 5 rounds loaded in each pistol magazine. You may have two extra magazines over what the stage calls for. Any magazine dropped during a stage is considered dead.

At the Buzzer, the shooter will rack the slide with trigger finger outside of trigger guard and begin course of fire. If the trigger finger is in trigger guard during racking of slide that is a SDQ.

When moving with pistol in hand, slide must remain open and trigger finger outside of trigger guard to keep from being penalized.

When finished firing pistol sequence, PISTOL WILL BE STAGED, NOT REHOLSTERED.

Shotgun will be noncomstock, i.e., Virginia count, i.e., no make ups.

At end of stage, if not locked open, show RO the pistol is clear and holster. If the shotgun is not locked open, show clear as well.

DRESS
