I have been asked to insert the following safety and range reminders in this newsletter.

Insurance and the Oakwood Outlaws require that all shooters attend the RANGE SAFETY MEETING ON MAIN STREET PRIOR TO THE MATCH, and anyone not in attendance will not be allowed to compete in the match. If you have a legitimate reason for being late, talk to the Range Officer and ask for a safety update and permission to shoot. It will be his choice.

All long guns must be carried with muzzle up at shoulder height.

When shooting on a posse it is your responsibility to stay with your posse and assist with posse duties, it is not appropriate to move on to another stage and practice. There is plenty of time for practice on the range after the match.

On the last stage, it is appropriate to stay and assist the posse until the last shooter finishes.

We really should not need to repeat these things, sometimes it becomes necessary.
